
Email Storage & Outlook

Save Message



- "Learns" destinations
- Two click filing



MessageSave – Additional Features



- Audit trail option
- Highly configurable

PROS:

- Time savings
- Simplicity in use
- Learns folder destinations to use

CONS:

- Initial add-on upsell
- Needs Outlook


Client Links & Connections

- Ease of management and team distribution

- Folders of shortcuts?

- Links in client procedure documents?




Remote Desktop Manager



- "Connections" Organiser
- Customisable Folder List
- Session type aware
 - 16 variants (RDP, pcAW,
 DWMRCS, http, Logmein,
 TeamViewer, VNC etc)
 - VPN options
 - Password Manager Support
- Systray Context Menu



Remote Desktop Manager – More...



- Not just connections
 - Folders
 - Documents
 - Command Shells...
- Sharing & Security
 - SQL Server +
 - Offline Mode
 - Enterprise Edition (~\$70 per seat)



Remote Desktop Manager – Summary

PROS:

- Excellent organiser
- Quick to get started
- Integrates well with other tools

CONS:

Still finding new things that it does!






What's my website availability?

- Website availability & responsiveness
- Shared and dedicated hosting

- External monitoring services
- RMM tool add in
- Hosting vendor services



Pingdom



- Uptime & response time reporting
- Failure alerts
 - Email, SMS, Twitter
- 40+ probe servers
 - Subscription based
 - Free option (1 site check)
 - From \$10 pcm (5 checks)



Pingdom – Summary

PROS:

- Reliable
- Simple to use
- Good alerting

CONS:

Probes limited to USA, Canada & Europe






Client Technical Documents

- Ease of update & distribution
- Mixed media support (digital & print)
- ++ somewhere for "E-Myth Revisited processes"

- MS Word
- Other WP packages
- Help Authoring Packages



Help + Manual



- Intuitive help authoring
 - WYSIWYG editing
 - Integrated screen capture
 - Multi format output: PDF, webhelp, ePUB, e-Book
- Multi user editing
- XML import extensible



Help & Manual – Summary

PROS:

- Intuitive, stable and quick to use
- Good quality PDF and web help production
- Professional output

CONS:

\$420 to \$595 per author seat

- Minimise custom coding

- Variety of Content Management Systems (CMS)
- Restrict to:
 - Microsoft development stack
 - Low entry price
 - Ease of content management




mojoPortal



- Open Source .NET CMS
- Highly functional
- Good community support
- Shared & dedicated hosting supported
- Multi DB engine: MS SQL (CE, 2005-2008, Azure), MySQL and others

mojoPortal – "Features"






mojoPortal – Custom Features

- Build using Visual Studio
 - Express Supported
 - C#
 - Custom Control
 - No mojo source fork required!
- Appears as standard feature
- Full user CMS capabilities
 - Security
 - Customisation
 - Styling



mojoPortal – Summary

PROS:

- High functionality straight out of the box
- Source freely available
- Readily extensible
- Active development program
- Good community support

CONS:

- C# skills ideally needed to develop custom features
- Lower profile than some CMS products
